

Name the Stick Insect — Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

Promoted by Aylesbury Homeless Action Group (AHAG), Registered Charity No. 1009983, 2 Rickfords Hill, Aylesbury HP20 2RX.

These terms and conditions govern the Name the Stick Insect free prize draw. By entering the draw, you confirm that you have read and agree to these terms. Please read them carefully before entering.

1. The Promoter

This prize draw is promoted solely by Aylesbury Homeless Action Group (AHAG), a registered charity in England and Wales. The draw is run in association with the Rothschild Foundation at Waddesdon Manor, Buckinghamshire, though AHAG is solely responsible for the conduct of the draw and the handling of all personal data submitted as part of entry.

2. The Draw

What it is: A free prize draw to choose a name for a large, climbable wooden stick insect — a new piece of play equipment in the playground at Waddesdon Manor, Buckinghamshire.

No purchase necessary: Entry to this draw is entirely free. No donation, purchase, or payment of any kind is required to enter or to win.

Legal basis: This is a free prize draw. The winner is selected entirely at random. No element of skill or judgement is involved in the selection of the winner. This draw does not require a licence under the Gambling Act 2005.

3. Who Can Enter

- The draw is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged 18 and over, or children of any age entering with the knowledge and consent of a parent or guardian.
- By completing and submitting an entry form, entrants under the age of 18 are assumed to be doing so with the knowledge and consent of a parent or guardian.
- Employees of Aylesbury Homeless Action Group, the Rothschild Foundation, Waddesdon Manor, and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter.
- AHAG reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any entrant and to disqualify any entry that does not comply with these terms.

4. How to Enter

- Complete the online entry form at the following address:

- You will be asked to provide your suggested name for the stick insect and your contact details (name, email address, and age or age range).
- One entry per person. Duplicate online entries from the same person will be discarded.
- After submitting your online entry, you will receive an automated confirmation. This confirmation will include an optional link to make a voluntary donation of £1 to AHAG via Give a Little. This donation is entirely optional and will not affect your entry in any way.

One entry per person. Family members living at the same address may each submit their own individual entry.

5. Entry Period

Draw opens: 31 July 2026, when the playground at Waddesdon Manor opens to the public.

Draw closes: 27 September 2026. Online entries must be received by 11:59pm on this date.

Entries received after the closing date and time will not be included in the draw.

6. The Prize

Main prize: The winning name will be engraved on a permanent dedication plaque, which will be the first ever dedication plaque placed in the Waddesdon Manor playground. The plaque will be unveiled during October half-term, 26–30 October 2026.

Additional prize: The winner will receive a family ticket for four people (two adults and two children) to attend the plaque unveiling at Waddesdon Manor during October half-term.

- The prize is non-transferable. No cash alternative is available.
- The prize is subject to availability. If circumstances outside AHAG's or the Rothschild Foundation's control prevent the prize from being awarded as described, AHAG reserves the right to substitute a prize of equivalent or greater value.
- The winner is responsible for any costs not explicitly included in the prize description.

7. Winner Selection

- The winner will be selected by random draw from all valid entries received by the closing date.
- The draw will be conducted by AHAG after the closing date.
- The random draw will not involve any element of skill or judgement. All valid entries have an equal chance of winning.
- AHAG's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the outcome of the draw.

Name approval

Before the winning name is announced publicly, it will be shared with the Rothschild Foundation for approval. The Rothschild Foundation reserves the right to exclude any suggested name that they consider unsuitable for permanent public display in the grounds of Waddesdon Manor — for example, because it is offensive, inappropriate for a family setting, or unsuitable as a permanent dedication. If a winning name is excluded on this basis, AHAG will conduct a further random draw from the remaining valid entries. This process will be repeated until an approved name is identified.

8. Notifying the Winner

- AHAG will attempt to contact the winner using the contact details provided at entry within 4 days of the draw taking place.
- The winner's name and winning name will not be shared publicly without the winner's explicit prior permission.
- If the winner cannot be contacted, or does not respond within 7 days of AHAG's first attempt to contact them, AHAG reserves the right to conduct a further random draw and select an alternative winner.

- Winners must confirm acceptance of the prize within 7 days of being notified. Failure to do so may result in the prize being forfeited and an alternative winner selected.

9. Voluntary Donations

A voluntary donation of £1 is suggested to support the work of Aylesbury Homeless Action Group. This donation is entirely optional and can be made via the Give a Little platform.

All donations received in connection with this draw will be match funded by the Rothschild Foundation. This means every pound donated effectively becomes two pounds in support of AHAG's work.

No donation is required to enter. Making or not making a donation has no effect whatsoever on an entrant's chances of winning.

10. Your Personal Data

Aylesbury Homeless Action Group is the data controller for all personal data collected as part of this draw. We take your privacy seriously and will handle your information in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

- We will retain your entry data for one year after the draw closes, after which it will be securely deleted.
- We will not share your personal data with any third party without your consent, except where required by law.

- Receive occasional updates and news from Waddesdon Manor / the Rothschild Foundation

- AHAG reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel this draw at any time if circumstances outside its control make this necessary. If the draw is cancelled, AHAG will make reasonable efforts to notify entrants.
- AHAG accepts no liability for entries that are lost, delayed, or not received for reasons outside its control.
- These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
- If any part of these terms is found to be unenforceable, the remainder of the terms will continue to apply.
